Day 1, Saturday, October 16, 2010: TO ISRAEL - Depart on our overnight flight to Israel.

Day 2, Sunday, October 17, 2010: ARRIVE IN ISRAEL - Arrive in Israel... Greeting and assistance by an Ayelet representative...Travel to Tel Aviv where we enjoy a welcome to Israel dinner!...Overnight Tel Aviv.

Day 3, Monday, October 18, 2010: THE ROOTS OF MODERN ISRAEL - Breakfast... Visit the multimedia Palmach Museum to “join up” with the pre-state strike force... Explore the nearby Weitzman institute where we learn about scientific advances coming out of Israel today... Drive through the main streets of Tel Aviv, the center of business and entertainment in Israel... See the “White Balhaus Arch”... Optional visit to an Art Museum... This evening we visit Beit Daniel to learn about Reform Judaism in Israel today... Overnight Tel Aviv.

Day 4, Tuesday, October 19, 2010: COASTAL VIEWS - Breakfast... Morning in Jaffa at the Jaffa Institute... Travel north via the coastal highway, stopping in Caesarea to view the ancient Roman ruins including the Roman Theater and Aqueduct... Visit the Yemin Orde Youth Aliyah Village, home to more than 500 children from across the world... Stop atop Mt. Carmel for breathtaking views of the Mediterranean Sea and the Bahai Gardens and Temple... Continue inland, arriving in the mystical city of Safed, where we view the ancient Ha’ari and Caro synagogues, and have time to browse among the many local artist studios... Arrive at our kibbutz where we check in and enjoy dinner... Overnight in the Galilee.

Day 5, Wednesday, October 20, 2010: THE NORTH - Breakfast... Morning jeep tour of the Golan Heights, including a stop atop Har Bental for views stretching into neighboring Syria... Explore the beauty of the north at the Tel Dan Nature Reserve... Visit the ancient town of Katzrin, dating back to the Talmudic times... Continue south, arriving in the Dead Sea, where we check into our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 6, Thursday, October 21, 2010: THE DEAD SEA BASIN - Breakfast... Free time this morning to float in the dead sea’s salty and healing waters... Continue to Masada to hear the story of the Jewish Zealots... Continue north to Qumran to explore the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found... Travel up to Jerusalem... Shehekienu from atop Mt. Scopus as we enter the city of gold... Free time for dinner on own... Enjoy a late night visit to the Western Wall and the Western Wall Tunnels for a dramatic introduction to the Old City... Overnight Jerusalem.

Day 7, Friday, October 22, 2010: JERUSALEM - Breakfast... Drive to Yad Vashem, the memorial to the Holocaust... Afternoon tour of the security wall and its impact on the area with a representative from Rabbis for Human Rights... Visit the Machane Yehuda marketplace as Jerusalem-ites busily prepare for the coming Shabbat... Shabbat Services at Kol Hanesama followed by Shabbat Dinner at our hotel... Overnight Jerusalem.

Day 8, Saturday, October 23, 2010: SHABBAT SHALOM! - Breakfast... Shabbat Services... Free time for lunch and relaxation... Late afternoon “Walking the Psalms” walking tour around the old city walls with Rabbi David Wilfond, who connects the sites we have seen with the poetry of the Psalms... Havdalah... Overnight Jerusalem.

Day 9, Sunday, October 24, 2010: THE OLD CITY - Breakfast... Explore the amazing City of David excavations, a fascinating look at the original foundations of Jerusalem... Visit the Old City of Jerusalem... Walk along the Cardo, the ancient Roman road, now as then a shopping promenade... Visit the four Sepharadic synagogues in the Jewish Quarter restored after the 1967 War... Walk through Jaffa Gate to David’s Tower Museum of the history of Jerusalem, and see the ancient remains of the city beginning with the First Temple period... Overnight Jerusalem.

Day 10, Monday, October 25, 2010: ISRAEL IN DEPTH/DEPARTURE - Breakfast... morning Hartman institute study experience... Visit the Dead Sea Scrolls at the Israel Museum and also see the model of Jerusalem... Remainder of the day at leisure for last minute shopping or relaxation... Farewell dinner celebrating our amazing tour... Transfer to Ben Gurion airport for our flight back to the USA.

Day 11, Tuesday, October 26, 2010: ARRIVE IN THE UNITED STATES - Arrive home in the United States.
