

JORDAN EXTENSION

3 DAYS & 2 NIGHTS

Sunday departure from Tel Aviv/Jerusalem

Day 1, Sunday:

- Pick-up at our hotel in either Tel Aviv or Jerusalem and drive to the Israel/Jordanian border at the Allenby/Sheik Husseini Bridge to enter Jordan.
- Proceed to Jerash, city of the Decapolis, located about 45 kilometers north of Amman, in the fertile heights of the Gilead. We visit the ancient Roman city with its colonnades and baths.
- Drive to Amman for a city tour of the Jordanian capital. Overnight Amman.

Day 2, Monday:

- After an early breakfast, we depart the hotel and drive south to Wadi Musa, the modern village of Petra.
- We travel through the "Siq" (canyon) (horseback ride optional), before traveling by foot to Petra, known as "Sela Edom" or Red Rock City, the ancient capital of the Nabateans from the 3rd Century BCE through the 2nd Century AD. Visit the most interesting monuments, the Treasury, El Khazneh (tomb of a Nabatean king), the field of tombs and Al Madhbeh (the altar) where we can view the entire city.
- Return to Wadi Musa and drive back to Amman for overnight.

Day 3, Tuesday:

- After breakfast, we drive to Madaba to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy Land and ruins of historical sites.
- Continue to Mt. Nebo, where Moses stood to view the Promised Land. From there we too see the Jordan Valley, Jericho, the Dead Sea, and more.
- Visit the remains of a Byzantine church with a mosaic floor, and then drive to the border and return to our hotel in Jerusalem or Tel Aviv.
