SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 11, 2024 DEPARTURE

• Depart the United States on your overnight flight to Israel.



MONDAY, FEBRUARY 12, 2024 BRUCHIM HABAIM – OUR MISSION BEGINS

- Various arrivals (aim for noon or earlier arrival). Upon arrival at Ben Gurion International Airport, we are met by an Ayelet Tours representative.
- 1:00pm: After a stop for a quick lunch on own, we travel to **Jerusalem**.
- 2:30pm: At **Hadassah Hospital**, we offer care for those in need and hear a high-level update on the medical and psychological impact of October 7th and the war in Gaza.
- 5:30pm: We check into our hotel and refresh.
- 7:30pm: Following our welcome dinner, a leading Israeli journalist shares with us "The Lay of the Land in Israel After October 7th" (possibilities include Matti Friedman, Gil Hoffman, or Haviv Rettig Gur).

DAY 3

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2024 JERUSALEM

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- 9:00am: Col. Res. Grisha Yaakubovitch, who served in the IDF Civil Administration in the Gaza region, briefs us on *"The Gaza Story"*.
- 10:30 am: We visit the Hamal Hayerushalmi in the Sam Speigel Film School complex, the Jerusalem Civil Coordination Center, for a briefing with Adir Schwartz, a Jerusalem community leader and one of the founders of the center. This is followed by an opportunity to take part in the volunteer effort.
- 1:00pm: Lunch on own.
- 2:00pm: This afternoon, we volunteer at the Ahim Laneshek (Brothers in Arms) Volunteer
 Center, to assist in the massive effort to help soldiers in both the south and the north. We share songs and prayers of comfort.
- Dinner is on our own this evening.

Overnight in Jerusalem (B)

DAY 4 WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2024 GAZA BORDER 🕏

- Breakfast and check out of our hotel.
- 8:30am: We meet with Gil Hoffman to discuss the current political landscape of Israel and Honest Reporting's analysis of the stories, articles, op-eds and images that appear in the media's coverage of Israel regarding the war in Gaza.
- 9:30am: We drive to the Gaza Border Region and volunteer in the fields, orchards, or packing houses of one of the moshavim.
- 1:30pm: In Shokeda, we cook for the soldiers at the Soldier Refreshment Center. Since October, this site has helped re-energize soldiers on the front lines in Gaza.
- Lunch is included en route.
- 4:30pm: Later this afternoon, we tour Kfar Aza and hear the horrific stories of what happened here on October 7th, followed by a stop at the Nova Festival site.
- 7:00pm: We continue to **Tel Aviv** to check into our hotel, followed by dinner on own.

DAY 5

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2024 TOUCHING BASE

- Breakfast and check out of our hotel.
- We begin our day visiting evacuees from the Nahal Oz community. We meet with Rabbi Yael Vurgan, leader of the Shaar HaNegev Progressive community, to learn about her work with the families and communities there following October 7th.
- We drive to Eden Inn to help cook for displaced families and soldiers and eat lunch together.
- At **Tel Hashomer Hospital**, we meet with wounded soldiers.
- We continue to a meeting with **Za'akah** to hear about their heroic work during and after the October 7th massacre.
- Next, we visit the Hostage Task Force Center in Tel Aviv for an understanding of what is being done to raise awareness of the hostage situation and meet with one of the families.
- We join in the daily Reform prayer at Hostage Square, where families, locals and visitors pray as one.
- At our **farewell dinner**, we reflect on all we have seen and experienced together.
- After dinner, we transfer to **Ben Gurion** International Airport for our return flight back to the United States.
