# PRE-DAY 1 WEDNESDAY, JULY 3, 2024 AMSTERDAM PRE-CRUISE

- Welcome to Amsterdam and your pre-cruise tour ahead of embarkation for our journey to Scandinavia. Upon arrival at Amsterdam airport, transfer to our beautifully appointed hotel in the heart of the city center.
- Early this afternoon, we ease into our exploration with a true immersion into Dutch culture and cuisine. We arrive to the neighborhood of Zaanse Schans, where we will visit a wooden shoe factory, cheese factory and Mill de Kat; the only remaining working windmill in the world built in 1646.
- After the tour, we return to our hotel for some time to regroup and refresh.
- In the evening, we come together for a festive **welcome dinner** at a favorite local establishment.

# PRE-DAY 2

#### THURSDAY, JULY 4, 2024

**PRE-CRUISE TOUR** 

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- Today, we enjoy a full day guided tour of Amsterdam. We meet our local guide and begin with a walking tour of the Jewish Cultural Quarter. We visit Verzetsmuseum Amsterdam, the recently completely renovated permanent exhibition of the Resistance Museum, which highlights the history of the Second World War and the German occupation. We continue to the Hollandsche Schouwburg, once a Dutch theatre of culture and entertainment turned deportation center, it is now a war memorial. We then visit the very significant Spanish/Portuguese Sephardic Synagogue to learn about the history of the Jewish community of Amsterdam. The Amsterdam Sephardic community was one of the largest and and richest Jewish communities in Europe during the Dutch Golden Age.



- We learn about the infamous Red Light District with time on own for lunch and exploration (local guides are not permitted to provide commentary within the RLD).
- After lunch, we continue to the Anne Frank House at Prinsengracht 263; the actual home-nowmuseum that chronicles the story of Anne Frank, her family and the others who hid with her from the Nazis through exhibits and original artifacts.
- Along our way, we pass by other historic sites, including **De Plantage**, Amsterdam's 17th Century backyard of rich and wealthy, **Spinoza Monument**, the famous **Dam Square** and the **Royal Palace**.
- We round out our very packed day with a relaxing cruise along Amsterdam's famous canal system, seeing this gorgeous city from a different perspective.
- Tonight, enjoy time on your own or choose to "follow the leader" to dinner.

Explore Berlin's united history, from division to allure, visiting sites like UNESCO's Museum Island and remnants of the Berlin Wall. Experience the city's vibrant culture, including beer gardens, restaurants, music, and arts scene.
