Tour Description: Founded in 1796, this 218-year-old shul, with its sand floors and an old-world charm is the second oldest synagogue in the Western Hemisphere. We will be joined by a member of the congregation who will provide us with a history of the synagogue and answer any questions you may have. Very casual attire – Photos are permitted.

Following the tour you will have the opportunity to enjoy some time in the heart of this capital city. Charlotte Amalie is a bustling island town and for those who love to shop or who just need a souvenir or two, the possibilities are endless. Only a short walk from the synagogue, this shopper's paradise offers some of the BEST bargains available throughout the entire Caribbean from perfumes, jewelry, linens and even dinnerware, to Caribbean souvenirs galore. If you're not a shopper but just want to settle into one of the many outdoor cafes for people-watching, there's a steady flow to see...by the sea.

Note: Transportation from the pier to the synagogue and a synagogue donation are included. Return to the pier on your own. To return to the ship from town and synagogue, plan on an approximate 1 ½ -2 mile walk (about 30 minutes) or you can take a readily available jitney ride for a nominal fee.

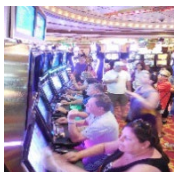

Tour Description: An invigorating hike in Martinique's tropical forest to discover the fabulous nature that is typical of this beautiful Caribbean island. Depart port of Fort de France, the busy administrative capital, and proceed on a short drive to Fontaine Didier. Accompanied by a local professional guide, we'll learn about the pristine tropical forest while embracing the aura of tranquility where singing birds, lush vegetation and running waters rule the day. You'll have the opportunity to cool off in a waterfall river before returning to Fort de France, or continuing on to enjoy some local sights, sounds and flavors on our Southern Island & Tasting Tour.

Note: This is an easy-moderate hike with some minimal grades. Hiking path is unpaved and may contain uneven or rocky terrain in spots. There are no changing facilities other than nature. Path may be wet or muddy. This is an active tour; participants with certain physical limitations should consider their comfort level and ability.

***If you are participating in both tours today, please be prepared for the day as you will not have time in between to go back to the ship in between.**

Then, head to a beautiful beach where you can soak up the sun and enjoy a refreshing swim in the Caribbean Sea.

Note: *This tour will not be accompanied by a BDA host. Guests must wear helmets while riding the ATVs. Guests must consider their physical fitness level and medical history when determining whether this tour is appropriate. You may get dirty, muddy or wet.
