- We continue to the Druze Village of Buq'ata, where we meet Naseeba and hear her story while enjoying a cooking workshop of stuffed vegetables, grape leaves and a traditional Druze hospitality lunch.
- Free afternoon and evening, with dinner on your own in Safed.

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2024ON THE WAY TO JERUSALEM

- Breakfast and check out of our hotel.
- This morning, we travel west to the Crusader port of Akko and tour the massive Hospitaller
 Fortress and Knight's Hall. We learn about this historically important port, through its use during the British Mandate.
- We arrive at Hadassah's Meir Shfeyah Youth Aliyah Village where we will enjoy an insider's tour of the farm, winery and music classes.
- Lunch on our own.
- We ascend to Jerusalem and upon arrival we stop at the Montefiore Windmill in Yemin Moshe, a historic Jerusalem neighborhood and home to artists and musicians, where we have a "Shehecheyanu" ceremony.
- The balance of the afternoon is free to rest and relax.
- This evening, we enjoy a Biblical dinner, featuring spices and ingredients mentioned in the Torah, including a workshop with a Sofer Stam (scribe) to learn this amazing ancient art.

- This morning, we visit Hadassah Medical
 Organization's (HMO) Ein Kerem Campus for

 Hospital Tower and the iconic Round
 Building, featuring the most modern hospital
 facilities in the region. We meet with staff
 and patients and take an in-depth look at this
 cutting-edge medical facility and how it has
 adapted to ever-changing needs. We end our
 visit at the Abbell Synagogue, home of the
 beautiful Chagall windows.
- Lunch on our own.
- Next, we set out on a geopolitical bus tour with Res. Col. Danny Tirza who served in the Israeli intelligence community and retired from active duty at the rank of full colonel. After retiring from the military, he served as the Israeli Prime Minister's International Media Advisor. During our tour, we will learn about the current security and border issues around Jerusalem as we view the widely discussed security fence that runs from Ramallah to Bethlehem.

- At Yad Vashem, Israel's memorial to the Holocaust, we engage in an eye-opening experience as we view the many moving exhibitions, including the Hall of Names and the Avenue of the Righteous Among the Nations. We end with a memorial service at the Valley of the Lost Communities.
- Lunch on our own.
- We continue to Mt. Herzl, Jerusalem's
 military cemetery, where we pay our respects
 at the gravesites of Theodore Herzl, Golda
 Meir, Yitzhak Rabin and Shimon Peres.We
 also visit Remembrance Hall built to honor
 those who gave their lives fighting for Israel.
- This evening, we welcome Shabbat at the Kotel (Western Wall) with the people of Jerusalem, followed by a festive Shabbat dinner with Hadassah friends.

- Enjoy the morning at leisure to relax or attend **Shabbat services** on your own.
- We embark on a guided walking tour of the Yemin Moshe and German Colony neighborhoods and hear stories about what occurred there.
- We return to our hotel to meet with Khaled Abu Toameh, an Israeli-Arab journalist, lecturer and documentary filmmaker, to hear about the current state of Palestinian affairs.
- As Shabbat comes to an end, we join for Havdalah.
- Dinner on your own, followed by the Sound and Light Show Spectacular on the Old City Walls at the Tower of David.

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- Today, we travel south and visit one of the border villages to learn about living on the Gaza border after October 7, 2023 and the will to endure. This will be an emotional morning, but an important one as we share our support with residents.
- Next, we visit **Sderot** and meet with the children and community leaders in the Western Negev.
- We stop for a view into the Gaza of today and discuss the fallout from the war and the longterm out look for the region.
- where we participate in a unique hands-on agricultural tour and witness how Israeli innovation is literally making the desert bloom with crops grown out of some of the most inhospitable sands imaginable. We will pick and taste fruits and vegetables from the kibbutz's self-picking farm, encounter flying strawberries, tiny orange orchards, racing pigeons and herbal gardens. We complete our visit with a delicious **lunch**.
- Later, we visit the workshop of artist Yaron Bob. Struck by the terror of shell attacks, Yaron decided to transform something horrible into something beautiful and so began his artwork known as "Rockets to Roses."
- We return to Jerusalem for dinner together at Piccolino.
