SUNDAY, JUNE 16, 2024 DEPARTURE

We depart NYC on an overnight flight to Israel.

DAY 2

MONDAY, JUNE 17, 2024 WELCOME TO ISRAEL!

- B'rukhim Haba'im! Welcome to Israel! Just beyond passport control, an Ayelet Tours representative will meet us in the baggage claim area and assist us through customs.
- We visit the Hostage Task Force Center in Tel Aviv for an understanding of what is being done to raise awareness about the hostage situation.
- Joining us for lunch at Biga restaurant is a featured journalist who will share their perspective on "The Lay of the Land in Israel After October 7th".
- At Hostage Square, we meet with families of the hostages.
- We ascend to Jerusalem for a welcome ceremony at the Kotel (Western Wall).
- After checking into our hotel, Hadassah Medical Organization (HMO) medical professionals join us for our welcome dinner.

DAY 3

TUESDAY, JUNE 18, 2024 HADASSAH HOSPITAL

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- At Hadassah Medical Organization's (HMO)
 Ein Kerem Campus, we meet with hospital staff to learn about HMO on the front line.
- We take an in-depth look at this cutting-edge medical facility Observing and learning about the impact the hospital has on the Jerusalem and Israel people.
- We join for lunch with Hadassah staff.
- Experts on sexual violence address us in a panel discussion about "Shattering the Silence."
- At the Israel Ministry of Foreign Affairs we receive a special update by officials.
- We meet with Rachel Goldberg, mother of Israelihostage Hersh Goldberg-Polin.
- Dinner is on our own in Jerusalem.

DAY 4

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 19, 2024 OFFERING SUPPORT

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- We visit Hadassah Medical Organization's
 (HMO) Mt. Scopus Campus, featuring the new Gandel Rehabilitation Center and meet with IDF soldiers being treated.
- Ichud Hatzalah, United Hatzalah, is a
 "community-based volunteer emergency
 medical services (EMS) organization
 committed to providing the fastest response
 to medical emergencies across Israel" free of
 charge." We meet with EMS volunteers, learn
 about the organization's specially equipped
 motorcycle ambulances, and assist in their
 work.
- After lunch on our own, we visit Hadassah's Neurim Youth Village for an insider's tour of the facilities, including the opportunity to meet with staff and students.
- We return to Jerusalem and are hosted for dinner by HMO nurses and medical professionals.

DAY 5 THURSDAY, JUNE 20, 2024 WITNESSING TRAGEDY & L'HITRA'OT

- Breakfast and check out of our hotel (posttour participants will not check out of the hotel).
- We drive south to Sderot where we visit the Police Station which was overrun by Hamas terrorists on October 7th.
- We meet with Magen David Adom (MDA)
 medics whose Sderot teams were the first on
 the scene on October 7th.
- Over lunch at the Salad Trail, Uri Eilon, its owner and founder, shares his horrific story of what occurred on October 7th.
- We visit the site of the Nova Music Festival for a special memorial ceremony.
- At a kibbutz in the Gaza Envelope (Western Negev), we hear members' stories about what happened on October 7th and their lives since.
- After our farewell dinner at a restaurant, we transfer to Ben Gurion International Airport for our overnight flight to the USA. (Post-tour participants will return to Jerusalem.)

- At Mount Herzl, Israel's national cemetery, we pay our respects at the gravesites of Israel's past leaders and the heroes of Israel's current war.
- We enjoy a culinary tasting tour at Machane Yehuda, where we take in the sights, smells, and sounds of the market as Jerusalemites busily prepare for Shabbat. This is the perfect place to purchase a gift for our Shabbat dinner hosts.
- We tour the Jewish Quarter in the Old City and have time for shopping and lunch on our own.
- After refreshing at our hotel, we return to the Kotel (Western Wall) to welcome Shabbat, then are hosted by medical professionals for Shabbat of a Lifetime.

- We return to the hotel for Havdalah and a late check out, then transfer to Ben Gurion International Airport for our overnight flight to the USA.
