## DAY 2 WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2024 BIENVENIDOS A ARGENTINA!

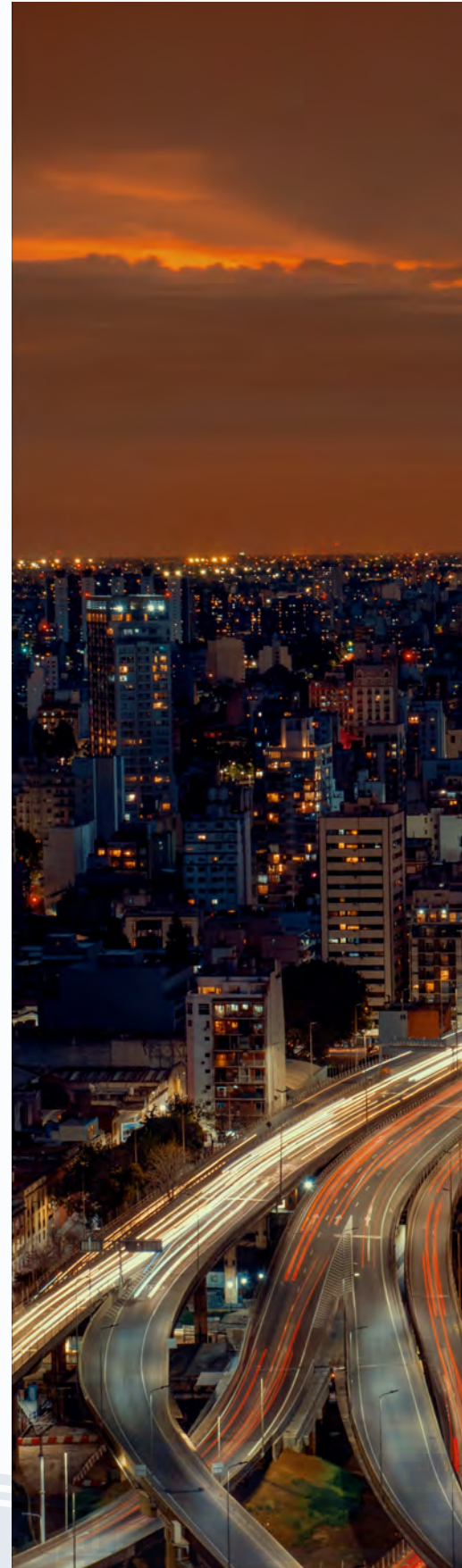
- Bienvenidos a Argentina! We arrive in **Buenos Aires**, the land of tango and the country's capital, as well as the political, economic and intellectual center. Upon arrival, we will be met by an Ayelet Tours representative and assisted through customs and baggage claim.
- We transfer to our hotel to check in and have a chance to freshen up.
- This evening, we join together for a delicious **welcome dinner** at our hotel.

## DAY 3 THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 29, 2024 GETTING TO KNOW BUENOS AIRES

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- We begin our day at **Plaza de Mayo**, scene of countless political demonstrations throughout the years. Here, we visit the **Metropolitan Cathedral** to appreciate its towering ceiling, striking stained glass, marble columns and paintings.
- We continue with a visit to the colorful **La Boca** neighborhood with its European flair due to many of its early settlers being from Genoa, Italy. We stroll along "**Caminito**" and admire the streets filled with souvenir shops and Tango dancers. Along the way, we pass by the **Boca Juniors soccer stadium**.
- We drive to **Puerto Madero**, a district made with recycled docks, where some of the city's best restaurants are located. Here, we see the **Woman's Bridge**, the capital's new emblematic icon.
- We enjoy **lunch** at a restaurant in Puerto Madero.
- We complete our day with a drive along "**9 de Julio**", the widest avenue in the world, arriving at the **Teatro Colon**, one of the most stunning buildings and important landmarks in Buenos Aires. Occupying a whole block, the opera house was built in 1908 when the demand for opera increased. We visit the different rooms, such as the **Gold Hall** and appreciate its imposing architecture and ornate decorations that create an elegant atmosphere.
- Evening at leisure to explore and enjoy dinner on own.

## DAY 4

FRIDAY, MARCH 1, 2024  
RECOLETA & PALERMO

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- This morning, we begin with a visit to **La Recoleta**, one of the city's most glamorous neighborhoods. Along Alvear Avenue, we see countless upscale stores, restaurants, cafes and boutiques, as well as the **Recoleta Cultural Center**, the **National Museum of Fine Arts** and the **Palais de Glace**, which are all important parts of the city's culture.
- We drive by many beautiful parks and see the **Floralis Generica** at United Nations Park, in addition to **Libertador** and **Figueroa Alcorta Avenues** on our way to **Recoleta Cemetery**. Founded in 1822, it is one of the most prominent cemeteries in the world. We stroll through to view the ornate mausoleums, sculptures and vaults made famous by local and international artists. Many heroes, presidents, well-known writers, scientists and artists are buried here, including Evita Peron.
- We continue to **Palermo**, a district with beautiful parks and artificial lakes. We enjoy some free time to visit the trendy neighborhoods of **Palermo Soho** and **Palermo Hollywood** to shop in the designer boutiques and enjoy **lunch** at a fashionable cafe or restaurant.
- We return to our hotel for a chance to freshen up before **Shabbat services and dinner** this evening.

## DAY 5

SATURDAY, MARCH 2, 2024  
SHABBAT SHALOM/TOURING TIGRE

- Breakfast at our hotel and a leisure morning to explore on own or relax.
- This afternoon, we depart for the outskirts of the city. **Tigre** is a popular weekend getaway for many "porteños" and boasts many summer homes as well as yacht and rowing clubs. The **Tigre Delta** is one of the most attractive areas for visitors due to its rivers, streams and numerous green islands. We enjoy a **short cruise** along the channels of the **Parana-Delta** to see islands covered with lush vegetation.
- We return to our hotel for a free evening and dinner on own.

## DAY 6

SUNDAY, MARCH 3, 2024  
TO PUERTO IGUAZU

- Breakfast and check out of our hotel.
- This morning, we transfer to the airport for our short flight to **Puerto Iguazu**. Upon arrival, we will be welcomed and taken to our hotel on the Argentinian side to check in.
  - We set out again and drive through the National Park until we reach the **Brazilian side** of the falls. From here, we walk along the paths and take in the lush vegetation, butterflies and cascades. Our path leads us to the amazing panoramic view of the **Devil's Throat**, where we see the incredible scene that includes the iconic sites in Argentina like the **Two Sisters** and **Bozzeti waterfalls**, the **Superior Circuit** and **San Martin Island**, where the movie "*The Mission*" was filmed.
- We return to our hotel for **dinner** together this evening.

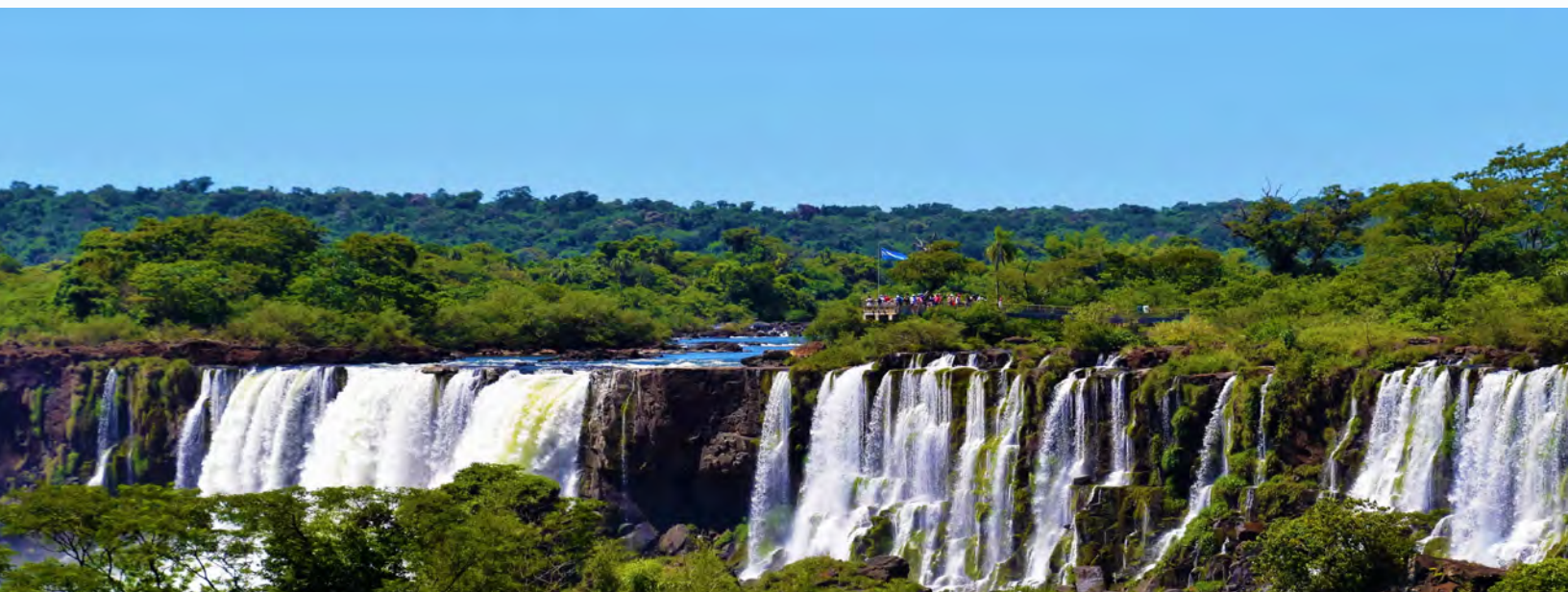
### Overnight in Iguazu

## DAY 7

MONDAY, MARCH 4, 2024  
IGUAZU NATIONAL PARK

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- Today, we discover Iguazu by **viewing the falls** from the Argentinean side, which consists of 275 different waterways that come together and fall 250 feet in a crescendo of astounding beauty. The Iguazu is wider than Victoria Falls, higher than Niagara Falls and more beautiful than both! We arrive by gas propelled train to tour the **Upper Circuit** route, including a visit to the famous **Devil's Throat**, the most magnificent of the falls, where we view and photograph the thundering waters falling below. From here, we walk along the **Iguazu River canyon** to the **Lower Circuit** while admiring the flora and fauna.
- We continue on **all terrain trucks** through the jungle in the humid subtropical forest to the edge of the banks of the Iguazu River. From here, we board special **high-speed boats** that take us up close and personal with the Iguazu Falls.
- Later this afternoon, we return to our hotel for a chance to relax.
- This evening is at leisure with dinner on own.

## DAY 9

**WEDNESDAY, MARCH 6, 2024**  
**JEWISH BUENOS AIRES**

- Breakfast at our hotel.
- This morning, we set out for the **Once area**, a neighborhood where most of the city's Jewish institutions are located. Here, we will pass by the **Hebraica JCC, synagogues, Jewish theaters and schools**, as well as **rabbinical seminaries**.
- We will also drive through the **Mea Shearim of Bam**, where the Orthodox Jews live, stopping for a one-hour tour at the site where the **AMIA** was bombed in 1994. The community center offers different programs for education, employment, culture and arts. We see the **memorial** dedicated to the 85 people who lost their lives.
- We stop for **lunch** at a local restaurant.
- We continue our tour at the **Jewish Museum**, where we learn about Argentine-Jewish culture and history.
- Our final stop is at the **Libertad Synagogue**, founded in 1862 and the first synagogue in Argentina. It was declared a Historical National Monument in 2000.
