- Should you test positive while abroad, **get an official certification of positive test result**. Having this may impact when you are able to re-enter the United States.
- **Travel insurance is mandatory for many destinations**. Even for those where it isn't, please don't take a chance. You could be out of pocket a significant sum if unable to return to the U.S. due to an unexpected positive test at the end of your trip. Get the protection you need, including “Trip Delay” coverage. - Be sure you bring **extra medication** to have on hand should your return home be delayed.
